Male Sexual Orientation Genetics Research Depends on Families

Sexual orientation is a fundamental trait of great scientific interest. Understanding the origins of sexual orientation will enable us to learn a great deal about sexual motivation, sexual identity, gender identity, and sex differences. Our primary goals are scientific, but we hope to also accomplish greater societal understanding.

Researchers from the NUS Research Institute, Northwestern University, University of Chicago, and University of Illinois at Chicago are seeking families with two or more living gay brothers to assist us in our research. Participants are asked to provide DNA samples (blood or saliva) and answer questionnaires.
